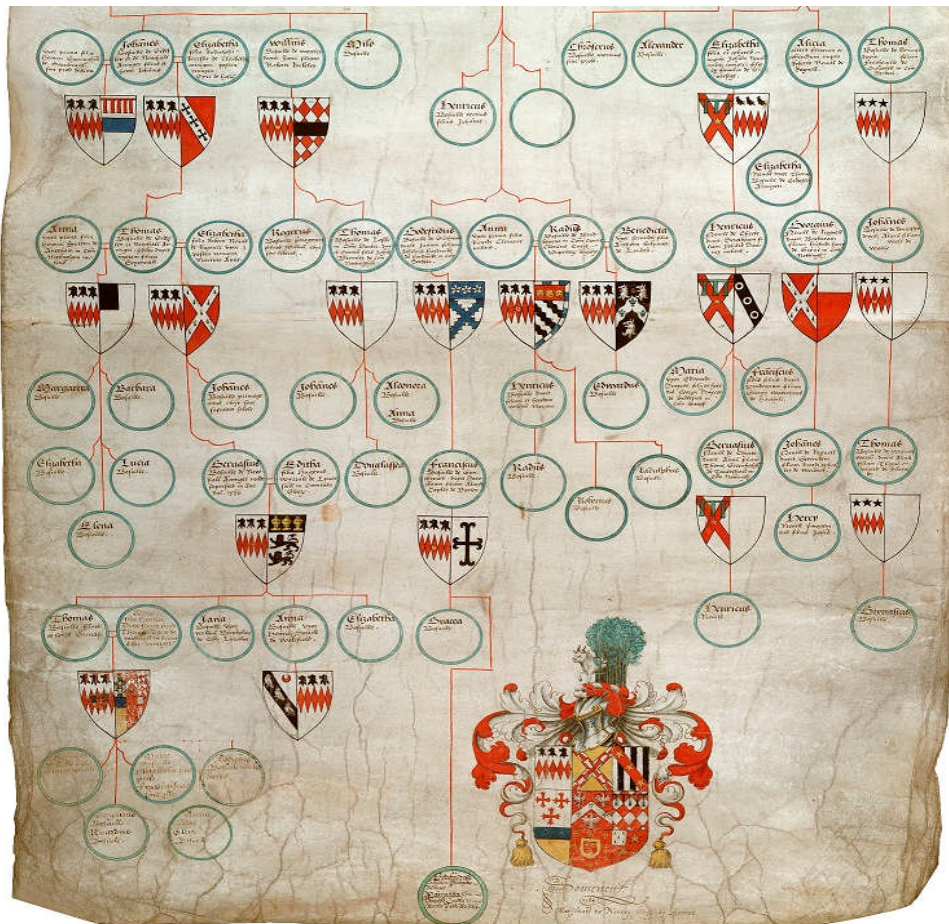

Introduction

Hull History Centre holds over 2000 collections which cover a huge range of subjects. Finding your way through this to identify material that interests you can be daunting.

The following is a guide to materials held at Hull History Centre on the subject of Landed Families and Estates. The guide is intended to aid the researcher in the identification of archival collections for use in research projects, dissertations and theses.

Entries in this guide provide brief summaries of individual collection titles, covering dates, and content. Hints and Tips

In addition to the below collections, there may be other material relating to landed families and estates amongst the holdings of Hull History Centre. You can identify this material by using the online catalogue (link above). Try key words such as the surname of a family, an estate name, the name of land or areas known to be part of an estate, or terms such as 'family', 'estate', 'deed' etc. Searches such as these might turn up individual items such as letters, reports, newspaper articles and so on hidden within seemingly unrelated collections.
